

**Military Installation Mapping Tools V 1.0**  
**November 30 2003**  
**Installation Instructions**

\*Refer to the **mimt\_doc.pdf** for more detailed instructions.

**Install Program: \*If you have problems see notes below**

1. Make sure that is a previous version of these tools exist that you have uninstalled the tools. Also, make sure ArcMap is closed during the uninstall process.
2. Unzip these files in a new folder where you can store this information.  
ITAM\_Map\_Template\_v1.zip  
MIMT\_ITAM\_v1\_0.zip
3. Please review the 'Requirements' section below. If you do not know if you have write access to the below directories, the setup.exe will exit and will not install MIMT.
4. When files have been unzipped, Double Click on Setup.exe.
5. Once the tool has been setup you will be required to select the tool in ArcMap:

Navigate to Tools | Customize  
check Military Installation Mapping Tool - MIMT  
(the 8 tool icons should appear in the menu area)

If the tool is not listed then select 'Add from File...'.  
Navigate to \Program Files\Marginaliatool\MIMT\MIMT\_v1\_0.dll.  
Select 'OK'. The program should be listed now. Check the box  
next to the tool.

**Requirements:**

- A. The user must have full permissions to the following directories:  
C:\Program File\Temp  
C:\\ Windows\System (Windows 95)  
OR  
C:\Winnt\System32 (Windows NT)  
OR  
C:\Windows (Windows XP)
- B. The User must have approximately 20Mb available on C: to install.
- C. WinZip 8 or higher is required to unzip these files. If you do not have WinZip, the setup will inform you and then exit. The WinZip program can be obtained at <http://www.winzip.com/>

*\*Do not delete or move any of the files once the Setup.exe has been run.*

*\*Only use the Windows Add/Remove Programs to uninstall the software.*

## **Uninstall Program:**

1. Navigate to Start|Control Panel|Add/Remove Programs...
2. Remove Military Installation Mapping Tool - MIMT

## **Potential problems for installation setup:**

1. The original seven files being copied over to your system may already exist, however, if the file included in MIMT is more recent, this is instructed by the setup program, then replace the file. Other wise do not replace the file/files.
2. If at any time a file is missing and the setup application instructs the user of such a case, write down the file name and location, and then follow the steps below:

Complete the setup and navigate to the Cabinet file in \MarginaliaTool\  
Double click on the MIMT\_v1\_0.cab file. You must have WinZip or something comparable to read the file. Extract the missing files and then copy and paste them into the directories instructed during the setup.
